Episode 2: How to self land your kite.



Have the kite low at the edge of the window. In this case, landing on the left side of the window, have the leash attached to a right line, either front or rear.

Make sure there is space downwind of you in case the kite does not land properly. Unhook and start to steer the kite down.

Commit to steering it down hard. If it's not leading edge down, it won't land properly.

Let go of the bar when the kite is about 1.5m or 5 ft off the sand.

The bar will slide up the leash line and the kite will pivot around the leash line. As it drops, it'll spin into the wind.

The kite has landed. Make sure the kite will not catch the wind and take off again. It is recommended to leave your leash attached while you walk to the kite and put sand on it. However, this often happens, so if it is safe you can detach your leash and quickly weight your kite. If the kite does tumble downwind, refer to Issue 3 for how to self rescue and get to your kite.
